## Parent-Teacher CONFERENCES

All parents are required to have a conference with their child's teacher(s). Visit [tlsboone.us/scheduler](https://tlsboone.us/scheduler) to select the day and time that works best for you. You can also sign up via the TLSBoone app by scrolling all the way over to the "Scheduler" tab on the home page and selecting "Parent Teacher Conferences."

Please sign up for conferences by Saturday, prior to the week of conferences, so our teachers know their schedules and can plan accordingly.

When scheduling conferences, please be sure you select your child's teacher from the "Staff Member" drop-down to see their conference schedule openings.

You must sign up, cancel, or reschedule at least 24 hours in advance. If you need to make changes to an already scheduled conference, please contact [connect@tlsboone.us](mailto:connect@tlsboone.us). Any changes that need to be made less than 24 hours in advance should be made directly with your child's teacher.

## ILSTO APPLICATION

The Iowa Lutheran School Tuition Organization (ILSTO) is now accepting tuition assistance applications for the 2026-2027 school year. This program provides financial support to qualifying families with students in grades K-12 attending a Lutheran school.

Applicants must be Iowa residents, have a household income at or below 400% of the federal poverty level, and must also apply for an ESA.

## SIGN-IN/SIGN-OUT

To help ensure the safety and accountability of all students, Trinity Lutheran School has updated procedures for late arrivals and early dismissals during the school day (8:10 AM-3:05 PM).

Students in grades K-4 must be signed in or out by a parent or legal guardian in the school office, and students will not be dismissed to meet parents outside the building. Students in grades 5-8 may sign themselves out for early dismissal only if the school has received prior communication from a parent or guardian.

All appointments, planned absences, or early dismissals must be communicated to the school in advance by email, phone, written note, or direct conversation with school staff. Please review the attached document for the full policy and procedures. Thank you for helping us maintain a safe and secure environment for all students.

Lent is a season that teaches us how to wait – and waiting is not always easy, especially for children. We live in a world where answers, entertainment, and solutions come quickly. But faith often grows in the quiet moments when we slow down and trust God’s timing.

This week, talk with your child about times when waiting feels hard. Whether it’s waiting for a special event, a game, or even an answer to prayer, remind them that God is always working, even when we cannot see it.

## WEEKLY DEVOTION

*“But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength.” – Isaiah 40:31*

Lent is a season of waiting.

We wait as we walk toward the cross. We wait as we remember Christ’s suffering and reflect on our need for His grace. Waiting can feel uncomfortable in a world that moves quickly, but Scripture reminds us that waiting on the Lord is never wasted.

God often works in the quiet spaces – the moments when we pause, pray, and trust Him to lead the way. Lent invites us to slow down, to turn our hearts again to Christ, and to remember that His promises never fail.

As we continue this Lenten journey, we look ahead with hope. The cross is coming, but so is the empty tomb.

- Apply It: Take a few quiet minutes this week to read a short passage from the Gospels and reflect on Jesus’ journey to the cross. Ask God to help you wait with patience and trust in His promises.
