FAMILY FAITH

SHARING ADVENT HOPE

Advent is a special season for families because it invites us to slow down and remember why we celebrate Christmas in the first place. Hope isn't wishful thinking or hoping things "go well."

Christian hope is confident trust in Jesus-the One who came to save us and who promises to come again. When families talk about this hope together, children learn that no matter what is happening around them, Jesus is their Light.

This week, take a few minutes each day to notice where you see signs of hope: a bright sky after a cloudy morning, a kind word from a friend, a moment of laughter at home. These small reminders help children see that God is present and working in their everyday lives.

 Try This: Choose one evening to turn off your regular lights and sit together by the glow of a candle or Christmas lights. Read Isaiah 9:2, then talk about how Jesus brings light into dark places. End by sharing one way your family can shine His hope to someone else this week.

WEEKLY DEVOTION

"The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone." - Isaiah 9:2

Advent is a season of waiting-but not an empty or uncertain wait. God's people long ago waited for the promised Savior, walking through seasons of darkness and silence, yet God gave them a sure promise: a great Light was coming. That Light is Jesus, born in Bethlehem, who came to save us from our sin and bring us into God's family forever.

Today we still wait—not for Jesus' first coming, but for His promised return. In the middle of busy schedules, worries, and a world that often feels dark, Advent reminds us that our hope doesn't depend on perfect plans or peaceful days. Our hope is in Christ alone—His cross, His empty tomb, and His presence with us right now.

 Apply It: This week, when you see Christmas lights-on a tree, in a window, or around townlet them remind you of Jesus, the Light of the world. As a family, choose one simple way to share His hope with someone else through a kind word, small act of service, or note of encouragement.
