You can also sign up via the TLSBoone app by scrolling all the way over to the "Scheduler" tab on the home page and selecting "Parent Teacher Conferences."

Please sign up for conferences by Saturday, prior to the week of conferences, so our teachers know their schedules and can plan accordingly.

WEEKLY DEVOTION

“Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me.” – Luke 9:23

Lent often feels like a wilderness season.

In Scripture, the wilderness is a place of testing, quiet, and dependence. It’s where distractions are stripped away and we realize how much we need God. When Jesus was tempted in the wilderness, He did not rely on His own strength. He clung to the Word of God.

There are seasons in life that feel dry – hard conversations, waiting, disappointment, unanswered questions. Lent reminds us that even in those wilderness moments, God is not absent. He is at work.

Jesus walked through temptation and suffering for us. And because He did, our wilderness is never without hope. Lent is not about proving ourselves to God. It is about remembering that Christ has already proven His love for us.

- Apply It: This week, when you feel stretched thin, pause and pray: “Lord, meet me here.” Open Scripture before you open your phone. Let God’s Word steady you in this Lenten season.

WALKING TOGETHER

Lent reminds us that seasons of challenge and growth are part of the journey of faith. Even children experience their own “wilderness” moments – frustration with schoolwork, friendship struggles, or learning to persevere when something feels hard.

As a family, create space this week to talk about those moments. Ask your child what feels challenging right now, and remind them that God meets us in those places. Model turning to prayer before reacting and to Scripture before worry. When children see faith practiced in real time, they learn that God is present not only in joyful seasons, but in difficult ones as well.

Lent is a gentle invitation to slow down together and remember that Christ walks with us through every part of life – and leads us toward hope.
