*"In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." – Matthew 5:16*

God has given each of us unique gifts—some of us are strong leaders, some are quiet encouragers, some create, some serve, some speak, and some sing. And when we use those gifts to glorify Him, something beautiful happens: His light shines through us.
