## WEEKLY DEVOTION

*"We love because He first loved us." – 1 John 4:19*

Valentine's Day often reminds us of cards, candy, and kind notes shared between friends. While those are sweet gestures, Scripture points us to a deeper kind of love—one that does not fade or depend on circumstances. God's love for us is not based on how we perform, how we feel, or what we give in return. His love is steady, sacrificial, and unconditional.

The greatest expression of love was not written on a card but shown on a cross. Jesus gave Himself for us so that we could be forgiven, restored, and called children of God. That love is the foundation for every other relationship in our lives.

Because we are loved so completely by God, we are free to show love to others—with patience, kindness, forgiveness, and compassion. Valentine's Day becomes more meaningful when we remember the source of all love: Christ Himself.

- Apply It: This week, talk about one way you can show Christ-like love to someone—through a kind word, an act of service, or forgiveness. Let your love reflect the greater love we have first received from God.
