#### CHRISTMAS SERVICE

Invite your family and friends to join us tomorrow, Friday, December 12 at 6:30 pm for our Christmas Worship Service. Our students will lead us in celebrating the birth of our Savior, sharing the true message of Christmas.

Doors will open at 6:00 pm (no earlier), and students must be in the parish hall by 6:15 pm. Attendance is required for all Trinity students. Students must wear dress/church clothes (no jeans, sweatshirts, t-shirts, or clothes with holes).

### **WEEKLY DEVOTION**

"And he will be called... Prince of Peace." - Isaiah 9:6

One of the beautiful themes of Advent is peace – not the kind that depends on everything going smoothly, but the peace that Jesus gives. When the Bible calls Jesus the "Prince of Peace," it reminds us that true peace comes from Him alone. He brings peace between us and God, peace in our hearts, and peace that steadies us even when life feels uncertain or chaotic.

This peace isn't fragile. It doesn't disappear when plans change or when days feel stressful. Jesus' peace is rooted in His love and His promises, and no circumstance can take that away. When we keep our eyes on Him, we can rest in the calm assurance that He holds us, forgives us, and walks with us each day.

 Apply It: This week, take a moment at the beginning or end of each day to pause, breathe deeply, and quietly say, "Jesus, thank You for Your peace." When the day feels busy or overwhelming, remind yourself that His peace is steady and sure – not because of our strength, but because of who He is.



# PRACTICING PEACE TOGETHER

Homes get busy this time of year – events, schedules, schoolwork, responsibilities. Advent invites us to step back and remember that our peace doesn't come from having everything

organized and calm, but from Jesus Himself. When families pause together and turn their attention to Him, children learn that peace is something the Holy Spirit gives, not something we have to "work up." This week, look for moments when peace feels hard – when schedules clash, when someone is frustrated, or when things feel loud or rushed. In those moments, gently remind your children (and yourself!) that Jesus is still near, still loving, still giving peace that cannot be taken away.

• Try This: Choose one "quiet moment" each day – maybe during dinner or before bedtime – to turn off distractions and sit together for a minute. Read Isaiah 9:6, take a deep breath or two, and simply say aloud, "Jesus is our peace." These small pauses help Advent become not just something we talk about, but something we experience as a family.
