WEEKLY DEVOTION

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast." Ephesians 2:8-9

In the hustle of our daily lives, where achievements often seem to define our worth, it's easy to drift into thinking that our spiritual life follows the same rules. We might catch ourselves wondering if we have done enough, been good enough, or prayed hard enough. Yet, Paul's words to the Ephesians remind us that our salvation is purely a gift from God, not a result of our own efforts.

This doctrine of grace assures us that our relationship with God does not begin with our actions but with His love and sacrifice. Grace is like the warm sunlight that fills a room at dawn—no matter how tightly shut the blinds are, the light finds a way through the smallest cracks. God's grace penetrates our lives, not because we earned it, but because He freely gives it.
