DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that Martin Luther, the founder of the Lutheran faith, believed passionately in the importance of education for all? He advocated for both boys and girls to be taught to read so they could study the Bible

for themselves, which was revolutionary for his time. Luther even translated the New Testament into German, putting God's Word into the language of everyday people so they could understand it directly. This commitment to learning and understanding Scripture continues today in Lutheran schools, where students are encouraged to grow in both knowledge and faith. Luther once said, "I advise no one to place his child where the Scriptures do not reign paramount." This legacy remains a core part of our mission, helping students build a foundation in both faith and academics.

FAMILY FAITH

LIVING IN GRACE

Grace is one of the most beautiful gifts God gives us. It means that even when we fail, forget, or fall short, God's love for us doesn't change. Through Jesus, our sins are forgiven, our hearts are renewed, and we are welcomed

into God's family-not because of anything we've done, but because of His mercy. When we begin to see how deeply we are loved by God, it changes the way we treat others. Homes filled with grace become places of understanding, patience, and joy.

Try it: This week, take time as a family to talk about what grace looks like in everyday life. Ask your children to share moments when they needed forgiveness or received kindness they didn't deserve—those are "grace moments." Choose a "grace word" for the week—forgive, kindness, mercy, or patience—and post it somewhere visible. As you notice and live out that word together, talk about how God's grace shows up in your home each day. These small practices help children see that grace isn't just something we talk about—it's something we live.

WEEKLY DEVOTION

"For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God." – Ephesians 2:8

At the heart of the Reformation is the message of grace alone—that our salvation is not something we earn, deserve, or achieve. It is completely a gift from God. Grace means that God loves us even when we fail, forgives us completely through Jesus, and welcomes us as His children—not because of what we've done, but because of what Christ has done for us.

This truth changes how we live and how we see others. When we remember that we are saved purely by grace, we become more patient, more forgiving, and more willing to share that same grace with the people around us. Each day is an opportunity to rest in God's undeserved love and to reflect it in our words and actions.

 Apply It: Take a few moments this week to thank God for His grace. Think of one way you can show grace to someone else-perhaps by forgiving quickly, offering encouragement, or choosing kindness when it's hard. God's grace is meant to flow through us to others.
