### WHAT IS IT?

The Trinity CHRISTkindl Market on Friday, December 5, 2025 from 3:00 - 7:00 pm is an exciting opportunity for Trinity students (Preschool–8th grade) to create and run their own small businesses. Students will make and sell products or services, applying lessons in money, creativity, and stewardship — and learning to give back to God through their work.

### **FAITH CONNECTION**

Each student will give back 10% of their total sales to Trinity Lutheran School as a way to thank God for His blessings. This reflects the biblical call to return the first portion of our blessings to God (*Proverbs 3:9*; 2 Corinthians 9:7). Through this experience, students will learn the Biblical principles of tithing and stewardship, recognizing that their time, talents, and treasures are gifts from God to be used wisely and joyfully. This event also provides an opportunity for students to reflect Christ's love in all they do — demonstrating honesty, fairness, and generosity in their business practices.

### **HOW FAMILIES CAN HELP**

- CHOOSE A PRODUCT/SERVICE: Work with your child to decide what to make or sell (crafts, baked goods, holiday gifts, artwork, services, etc.).
- PLAN SUPPLIES & COST: Discuss what materials are needed and how much they cost.
- SET A PRICE: Help your child calculate a price that covers costs and allows for some profit but remains fair and attractive to buyers.
- PREPARE TOGETHER: Assist with making products, practicing sales, and planning booth setup.
- TALK ABOUT TITHING: Discuss why we give back to God and help your child plan their tithe from the total earnings.

### AT SCHOOL

Teachers will lead age-appropriate lessons about money, giving, stewardship, and business skills. Students will explore everything from counting change and setting prices to budgeting and marketing, depending on their grade level.

### AFTER THE FAIR

Students will be invited to bring their tithe as a special offering during chapel. This will be a joyful celebration of God's blessings and their hard work.
