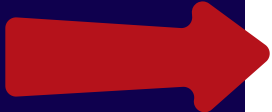

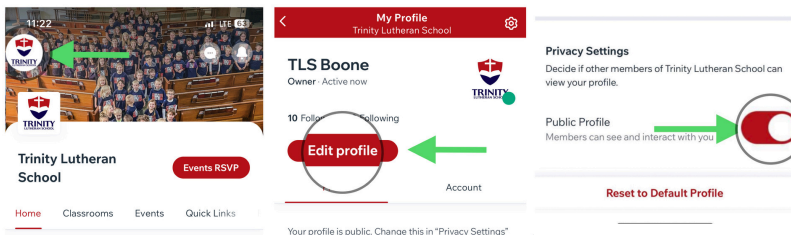

To make sure your profile is public please follow these steps:

1. In the TLSBoone App, click on your profile photo (left corner)
2. Click the "Edit profile" button
3. Scroll down and make sure "Public Profile" is toggled ON



WEEKLY DEVOTION

"Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." - Joshua 1:9

In life, we often find ourselves facing new challenges—whether it's starting a new school year, taking on a big project, or dealing with the unexpected. In moments like these, it's easy to feel nervous or unsure. Joshua 1:9 reminds us that we don't have to face anything alone. God's promise is clear: He is always with us, no matter where we go or what we face.

God commands us to be strong and courageous, not because we have all the answers, but because He is always by our side. When we rely on God's presence, we can find strength and courage, even when things seem hard or overwhelming.

Family Activity: Create a "Courage Collage" to remind your family of God's presence in your lives. Cut out or draw pictures, words, or Bible verses that remind you of times you've needed courage or experienced God's presence. Talk about how God was with you in those moments. Display the collage in a place where everyone can see it throughout the week as a reminder to be strong and courageous, trusting in God's faithful presence.

PIE TIME

Families are asked to volunteer based on their child's grade level:

- Preschool: 2 hours per quarter (8 hours annually)
- K-8th Grade: 4 hours per quarter (16 hours annually)
