What are

EDUCATION SAVINGS ACCOUNTS?

With the passage of the Students First Act, parents who enroll their eligible children (grades K-12) in an accredited non-public school will receive an amount equal to the per pupil funds allocated by the state to all public school districts each year. The funds are estimated at \$7,598 per pupil for the 2023-2024 school year and will be deposited into an education savings account (ESA) to be used for tuition, fees, and other qualified education expenses.

ESAs will be available based on the following eligibility:

YEAR 1 (2023-24)

- All kindergarten students
- All public school students

\$90,000 for a family of four

YEAR 2 (2024-25)

- All kindergarten students
- All public school students
- Private school students at or below 400% FPL
\$111,000 for a family of four

YEAR 3 (2025-26)

- All K-12 students in Iowa
Regardless of income

What is

ILSTO - (IOWA LUTHERAN SCHOOL TUITION ORGANIZATION)

IILSTO is a charitable organization that receives voluntary contributions from Iowa taxpayers and allocates those funds in tuition grants to Iowa school children, who in turn use those grants to attend a Lutheran School. **To be eligible your family income may NOT EXCEED 400% of poverty level as outlined below.
