A SIMPLE LENTEN FOCUS

Lent has begun, and it's a meaningful opportunity to slow down as a family and turn your hearts toward Jesus. While the season is reflective, it doesn't have to be heavy. It can be intentional.

Consider choosing one small Lenten focus as a family. You might read a short Bible passage together each evening, pray for someone specific each day, or set aside something small (like screen time or a treat) to create space for conversation and prayer. Keep it simple and doable.

As we move further into the school year, routines matter more than ever. A few small habits at home can make a big difference in your child's confidence, focus, and attitude each day.

Take a few minutes each evening to check backpacks, review assignments, and prepare for the next day.

Laying out clothes, organizing folders, and making sure everything is packed before bedtime helps mornings feel calmer and less rushed. Students who start their day prepared are better able to stay engaged and organized throughout the day.

Consistent routines also build responsibility and independence. When children practice small acts of preparation daily, they develop habits that support long-term success – both in school and beyond.
